



1. Engineering organisations – chambers and associations of Visegrad Four (V4) countries assembled at their 29th meeting on 5 to 7 October 2023 in Bratislava. The host and organiser of the meeting was the Slovak Chamber of Civil Engineers.
 2. The following delegations participated in the meeting:
 - Czech Chamber of Certified Engineers and Technicians (ČKAIT)
 - Czech Association of Construction Engineers (ČSSI)
 - Hungarian Chamber of Engineers (MMK)
 - Polish Chamber of Civil Engineers (PIIB)
 - Polish Association of Construction Engineers and Technicians (PZITB)
 - Slovak Chamber of Civil Engineers (SKSI)
 - Slovak Association of Civil Engineers (SZSI)
 3. On the first day, the conference “Motorway and Expressway Construction Strategy of the Visegrad Four Countries” was held. Information on the construction of motorways and expressways in the EU was presented by the President of the ECEC, followed by presentations by representatives of the Visegrad Four countries on the preparation and construction of the motorway network in the individual V4 countries.
 4. On the second day, the delegations continued their working session with the following agenda:
 - 4.1 Commemoration of the 28st anniversary of the meetings of engineering chambers and associations of the V4 countries
 - 4.2 Construction budgets and price indexation in the Visegrad Four countries.
 - 4.3 Length of liability of authorised persons in individual V4 countries.
- Representatives of the delegations of all participating V4 countries took the floor on each agenda item one by one.
5. The delegations discussed the issue of verification of budgets and bills of quantities by certified engineers and the direct responsibility for the processed budgets and bills of quantities by the designers. The delegations suggested that each of the Visegrad Four countries should promote the prepared budgets and bills of quantities for the design documentation as indicative, for the internal use of the investor/procurer of the construction project. At the same time, the budgets will be verified by the budget processor with their stamp and signature and not by the certified engineer – the responsible designer.
